**Scripture:** John 15:1-8

1. According to this passage what is God looking for in your life? How does He help you achieve it? How seriously does He take it?
2. What is the difference with "cut off" & "prune (v.2)?" What is the goal of each? What does this imply about what we should expect in our walk with God?
3. What do you think it means to "remain" in Jesus (v 5)? What are the benefits of remaining (vs. 5-8)? What are the consequences of not remaining (vs.5-8)? What can you do to remain in Him?
4. How can we prove that we are truly followers of Jesus (v.8)?
5. What does this passage teach us about judgment and God's attitude toward it?
